Terms and Licensing Policy

When submitting the paper(s) to ISARC, the author(s) accepts the terms of the ISARC Copyright Transfer Terms and Licensing Policy as follows:

1. The author(s) affirm that the paper has not been published elsewhere and will not be published elsewhere prior to ISARC.
2. The author(s) will grant to ISARC a nonexclusive, royalty-free, perpetual, worldwide, irrevocable, sub-licensable, and transferable license to publish the paper (in unmodified form) and its online presentation (such as video recordings) in any fashion (including but not limited to inclusion in the ISARC printed and electronic proceedings, via electronic means such as the world wide web, and inclusion in future compilations of papers). This “nonexclusive” license means that the author(s) are not restricted to future use of the material except that exclusive rights cannot be granted to another.
